LIGHT UP

MAKE SURE YOU CAN BE SEEN:

- Don't forget to **light up** when driving in or leaving an urban area that has street lighting
- If visibility is poor during the day due to heavy rain, snow, fog or mist, turn on your headlights so that your vehicle can be seen
- If visibility is seriously reduced, turn on your rear fog-lights but remember to turn them off when the visabilty improves so as not to dazzle other road users
- **Use your lights courteously**
- If your car has fog lamps, don't use them if there is no fog
- In fog, use only your low beam headlights; high beam reduces your own ability to see and may temporarily blind other drivers
- Avoid using your high beams when you see oncoming vehicles or when you drive in urban areas
